**INTERIOR DESIGNER MEGAN BROWN** aimed to create a luxurious ensuite as a retreat from the demands of busy family life. The oceanside location reinforced that the restorative powers of water and bathing were key. "We took inspiration from the immersive and healing qualities of a traditional hammam. A palette of tone on tone ethereal greys and whites provided a sense of rest while allowing us to manage dimensional constraints. The key feature is the floating vanity wall, the separation from the adjoining wall preventing a shortening of the space to maintain a sense of openness, while simultaneously creating the requested privacy. Our choice of materials is layered, textural and rich. Sensuality is dialled up by employing feminine curves in bath, tapware and mirror. The hidden success of this sanctuary is the abundance of storage within cleverly recessed custom mirrored cabinets.
